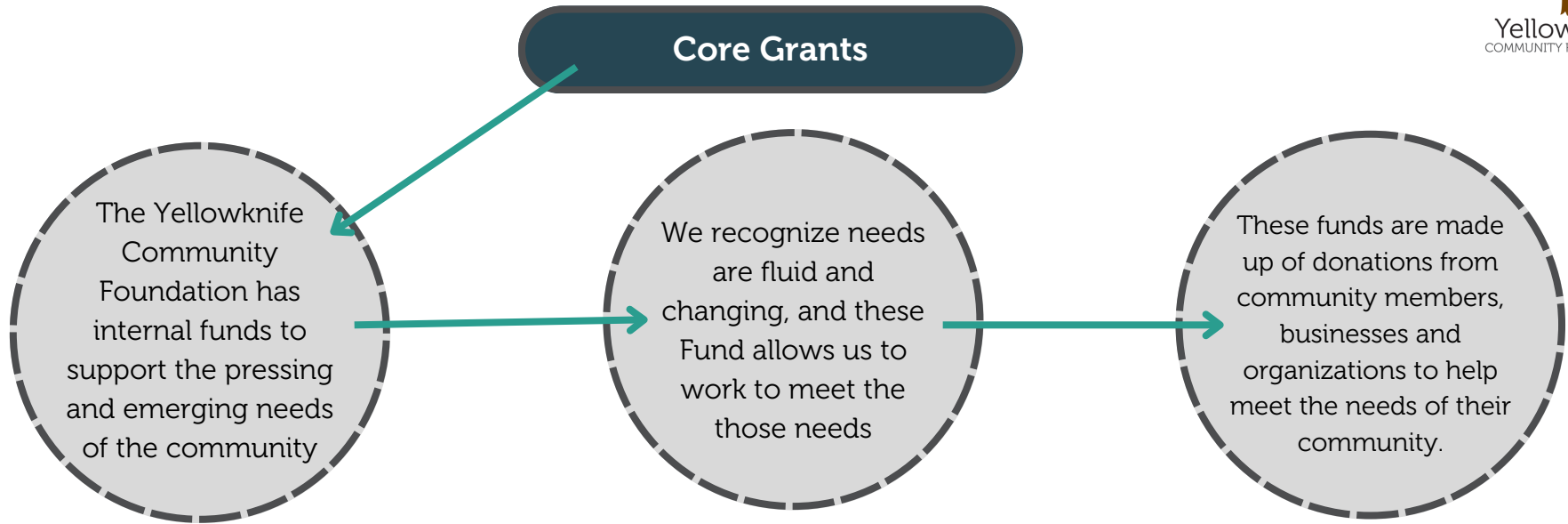


# YKCF 2023 GRANTS MAP



## Community Impact Fund

Grant applications to the Community Impact Fund are divided into two streams. An organization can apply once to each stream.

### Community Enrichment Grants

The purpose of the Community Enrichment stream is to support community initiatives in the Yellowknife, Dettah and N'Dilo areas. Organizations may apply for grants between \$1,000 and \$50,000 that complement their new and/or existing programs and initiatives.

Eligible costs: Capital projects incl. renovations, wages, purchase of equipment or materials, administration costs up to 15% of proposed budget

### Organizational Capacity Grants

The purpose of the Organizational Capacity stream is to support organizational needs and to help strengthen the non-profit and charitable sector in Yellowknife.

Organizations may apply for up to \$10,000 to support professional training or learning opportunities for staff or board members.
